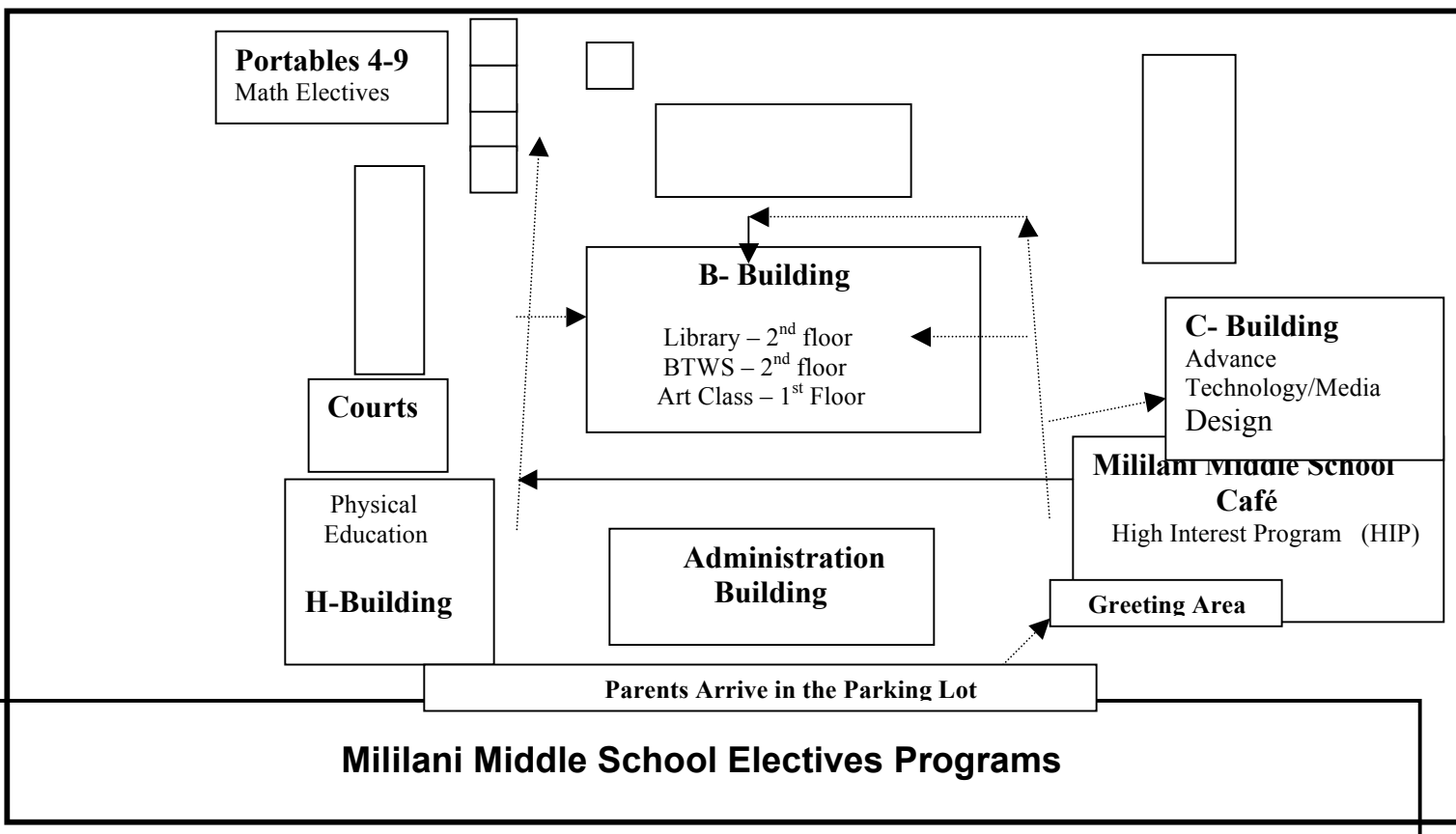
MEET & GREET FORMAT:
